

GNBTC 2006 Grand Prix (Cont...)

Additionally: Points will be given to the first five male and female finishers in the race on a descending scale: 1st=+5, 2nd=+4, 3rd+3, 4th=+2, 5th=+1. If less than five (5) runners participate in a particular division, the winner receives points equal to the number of finishers in that division.

Age Groups

Runners are placed in the age group based on their age on December 30th, 2007. This allows runners to race against runners in their age group for an entire year.

How to Enter

All members on the official GNBTC membership list by May 1, 2007 are automatically entered into the 2007 Grand Prix once they have raced at least 3 races. Members not wishing to be listed in the final grand prix results must notify the Grand Prix Coordinator in writing prior to September 10th to be left out of the final standings.

Results

Grand Prix results will be periodically listed in the GNBTC Newsletter after June 1st. Grand Prix results are based on information provided to the newsletter and the results listed on GNBTC website (<http://www.gnbtc.org>), said results are considered to be official GNBTC Race Results. Grand prix results cannot be updated until the official results have been submitted and have been made available to one of those sources.

Runners are responsible for ensuring the accuracy of the results listed on the GNBTC web site and in the newsletter. Race results or runners not listed in the official GNBTC Race Results will not be included in the Grand Prix. Runners are required to monitor the preliminary grand prix updates for errors and omission and to notify the Grand Prix Coordinator by September 10th of any errors. Runners will not be added to the Grand Prix after June 1st. Runners should report any errors in the newsletter or the GNBTC web site to results@gnbtc.org. Purpose

The 2007 Grand Prix series is meant to encourage GNBTC members to participate in some of our areas best local races. Participants race over a wide range of distances and courses and are given points for running races on the Grand Prix Schedule and placing in the Grand Prix age group.

Prizes

Prizes will be awarded to 1st male and female in the following age groups....
(Under 19, 20-29,30-39, 40-49, 50-59, 60 & Over)

An additional award will be given to anyone who.....

All participants who run all the races in the 2007 Grand Prix or...

Any runner who breaks the following times at a GNBTC Grand Prix race for the first time in the grand prix series...

5k	Male/18:30	Female/20:00
10k	Male/40:00	Female/43:00
½ Marathon	Male/1:30	Female/1:35

Series Rules

The runners with the most points at the end of the year will receive awards. To be eligible, a runner must complete in at least 3 races. Every runner who finishes the following races receives....
